

Spring Fellowship Attendees Provide Service at Camp

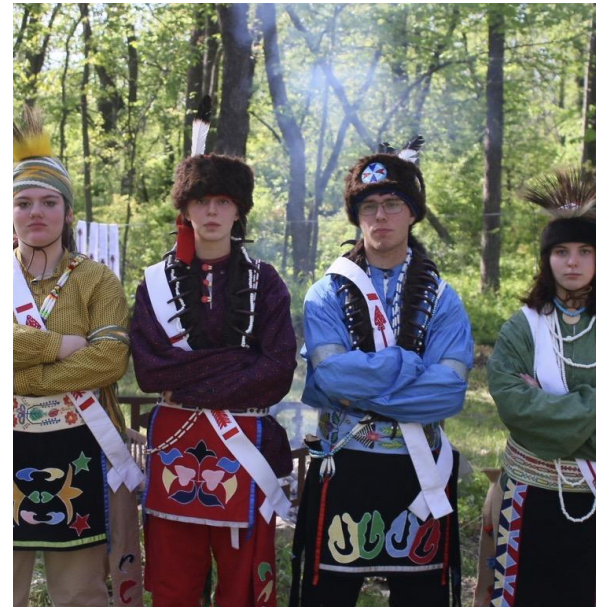

- Beforehand you must -
 - Memorize the Obligation, the Song of our Order, Sign of the Ordeal, the Handclasp, and the Admonition
 - Write a short reflection letter to the Lodge Chief

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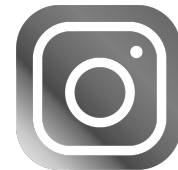
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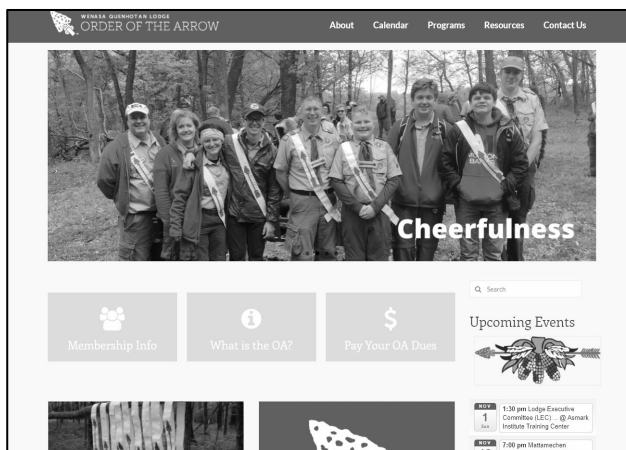
